**EDUCATOR LICENSURE**

26. Approval to begin the Administrative Procedures Act Process:  
To Approve New Praxis Tests and Cut Scores as Recommended by the Commission  
on Teacher and Administrator Education, Certification and Licensure Development

Background Information:

Educational Testing Service (ETS) has regenerated the following groups of Praxis tests. In September of 2011, ETS will begin administering these new tests replacing the existing exams. Mississippi and other states that use these tests must approve the new tests and new passing scores for all licensure candidates that are required to pass these tests.

They are:

1. Praxis II Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) - test 0621 or 5621 for grades PreK-K
  - Replacing the current test 0521
2. Praxis II Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) - test 0622 or 5622 for grades K-6
  - Replacing the current test 0522
3. Praxis II Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) - test 0623 or 5623 for grades 5-8
  - Replacing the current test 0523
4. Praxis II Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) - test 0624 or 5624 for grades 7-12
  - Replacing the current test 0524
5. Praxis II Art Education K-12 - test 0134 – replacing test 0133
6. Praxis II Technology Education 7-12 - test 0051 – replacing test 0050
7. Praxis II Audiology - test 0341 – replacing test 0340

At the May Commission meeting, the Commission approved a subcommittee to review new Praxis tests regenerated by ETS for the upcoming test administration year. MDE convened a committee on June 9, 2011 with representatives from ETS to set passing scores for these new tests.

The recommendations from the subcommittee that were presented to the Commission at the July meeting were as follows:

PLT PreK –	155
PLT K-6 –	155
PLT 5-8 –	155
PLT 7-12 -	155
Art -	158
Technology Ed	159
Audiology	(will be set by ASHA standard setting)

The cut score recommendations from the subcommittee on the four PLT tests were lower than the recommended score from the ETS national standard setting study. At the July 8, 2011 meeting of the Certification Commission, Dr. Burnham addressed these recommendations. He strongly encouraged the Commission to approve the recommended score from the national ETS standard setting panel, instead of the recommendation from the subcommittee on the PLT tests. MDE is taking a stand to increase all Praxis test score to the national average, just as we are raising the standards for student test scores. We want to be sure Mississippi cut scores are in line with other states and will no longer have the lowest scores in America on some tests. The Commission agreed with Dr. Burnham’s stand on cut scores and voted to approve the national recommended score as all other states are doing.
