

## Guidelines for Alteration on a Local School District's Calendar for Inclement Weather

Contingent upon final passage of House Bill No. 1156, Legislative Session 2011, for the 2010-2011 school year, the Board will consider the request of a local school district for the alteration of a local school district's calendar for inclement weather on a case-by-case basis based on the following guidelines:

- Districts closing schools for four days or less will be required to make up each school day missed (one day make up for one day missed).
- Districts closing schools for up to six days will be required to make up all six days (four of which must be full schools days with the option of making up the remaining days by adding a minimum of 55 minutes of instructional minutes during the school day).
- Districts missing more than six days may submit a written request for forgiveness for days missed in excess of six days by explaining why it is not economically feasible or practical to make up the additional days missed in excess of six days.
