Scope of Project: The purpose of this contract is to provide a teacher in the content areas of Dance/Movement and Theatre to students at the Mississippi School of the Arts. Additional teacher units are needed due to increased numbers of students and expanded programming, but no PIN is available for this position. The contractor will perform duties to include, but not limited to the following:

- Instruct and train students in movement/dance/theatre using best practices and data driven decision making;
- Create course goals, syllabi, assign lessons, evaluate student content mastery;
- Monitor and issue timely reports on student progress, keep accurate attendance records, and communicate regularly with parents;
- Produce, implement, and evaluate comprehensive standards-based curriculum;
- Apply best practices in instructional content area;
- Utilize developmentally appropriate, effective, classroom management practices;
- Design and implement formative and summative assessments in content areas;
- Collaborate with school administration, faculty, staff, parents, and community.

Personnel associated with this contract is a former employee of the Mississippi School of the Arts but is not related to any department employee of MDE.
